

PATTERSON MILL ATHLETIC BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIPS

2017-2018 Scholarship Application

General Information:

1. This application is to be used by a graduating, class of 2018, high school senior who will study at an accredited post-secondary institution or educational training program in the fall of 2018.
2. The student must be enrolled at Patterson Mill High School (PMHS) and have participated in at least one complete season as a PMHS athlete or manager of varsity team.
3. Current athletic eligibility will be verified by the PMHS Athletic Director.
4. The applicant is responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information, signatures and official documents. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions completely. Give specific dates and hours when required.
5. The Patterson Mill Athletic Boosters (PMAB) Scholarship Committee reviews and determines applicant eligibility criteria. Family members of the PMAB Booster Scholarship Committee are not eligible to apply for the scholarship. Criteria may include all or some of the following:
 - a. Academic achievement: Cumulative GPA of 2.0 (based on 4.0 scale) at the end of the second quarter (1st Semester).
 - b. Athletic participation as a player or manager
 - c. Essay quality
 - d. Leadership roles
 - e. Honors/Awards
 - f. Service to others
 - g. Work experience
 - h. PMAB membership by April 1, 2018

6. The PMAB Executive Board funded one \$1000 scholarship and five \$500 scholarships for school year 2017-2018. The \$1000 Scholarship is the "Malamute Service Scholarship" in honor of Isaac Pfarr and Rick Snyder who passed away while students at PMHS. All applications compete for the \$1000 scholarship, and if not awarded the Malamute Service Scholarship, all compete for the remaining \$500 scholarships. Criteria for the Malamute scholarship includes all of the criteria above, but with greater weight on the applicant's leadership and service to others.

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7. The Scholarship Committee invites individuals from the community to judge the essays using a standardized essay rubric. The judges have no association with current Patterson Mill students. The scholarship applications will be validated for eligibility, de-identified and number coded by the scholarship committee before being given to the judges for evaluation.
8. All documents submitted to the Patterson Mill Athletic Boosters Scholarship Committee become the property of the committee. Documents will not be released to the applicants nor will they be forwarded to any other institutions or agencies.
9. Scholarships will be announced and presented during the Senior Awards Assembly.

Eligibility:

The applicant:

1. Is a high school senior graduating from Patterson Mill High School (PMHS) in 2018.
2. Enrolled at Patterson Mill High School and have participated in at least one complete season as a PMHS athlete or manager of varsity team.
3. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 (based on 4.0 scale) at the end of the second quarter (1st Semester).
4. Eligible for participation in school activities at time of application and distribution of the award.
5. Validated acceptance into a secondary school.
6. PMAB member by April 1, 2018.
7. The application is due by 2:00 pm Friday, April 27, 2018 and MUST be placed in the PMAB mailbox in the school office/Attention: John Campo. Late applications will be disqualified. PLEASE PUT IN A SEALED ENVELOPE.

Limitations:

1. Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2018-2019 academic year.
2. Scholarship funds must be applied toward college fees, books and/or tuition.
3. If the student withdraws from their program of study prior to the funds being exhausted, the remaining funds must be returned to the PMAB as soon as possible.

2. Compose an original essay not exceeding 750 words. The essay must be legible, preferably typed, using correct spelling and grammar describing the following:

Essays that are word processed should use Arial, Calibri or New Times Roman font with a size no smaller than 10point and no larger than 14point. The essay should be double spaced and have 1" margins all around. All essays should be printed on plain white paper. No electronic submissions will be accepted.

3. Sealed High school transcript through the second quarter marking period (1st Semester).
4. Documentation of service hours completed (only "if" sponsor signature not possible on application).
