- C. Concessions: No more games will be held in Stadium for Spring Playoffs. Currently, Gross sales for Spring are approximately \$3,500.00 with Net Profits of Approximately \$2,500.   - b. Sue reported that some of the items on the Health Department Inspection had been corrected. She will continue to monitor the progress of the corrections.
